DRESS CODE for students at Bookridge Day School

In anticipation of the long, hot summer months from now through fall, we want to share with you some information about the Kansas Health Department regulations concerning sunscreens. In order for the staff to apply sunscreen at school, parents must sign a medical release form, as with any other medication. These are available at the office. We ask that sunscreen be applied at home before coming to school for morning protection, and then, we will apply it before the afternoon recess.
